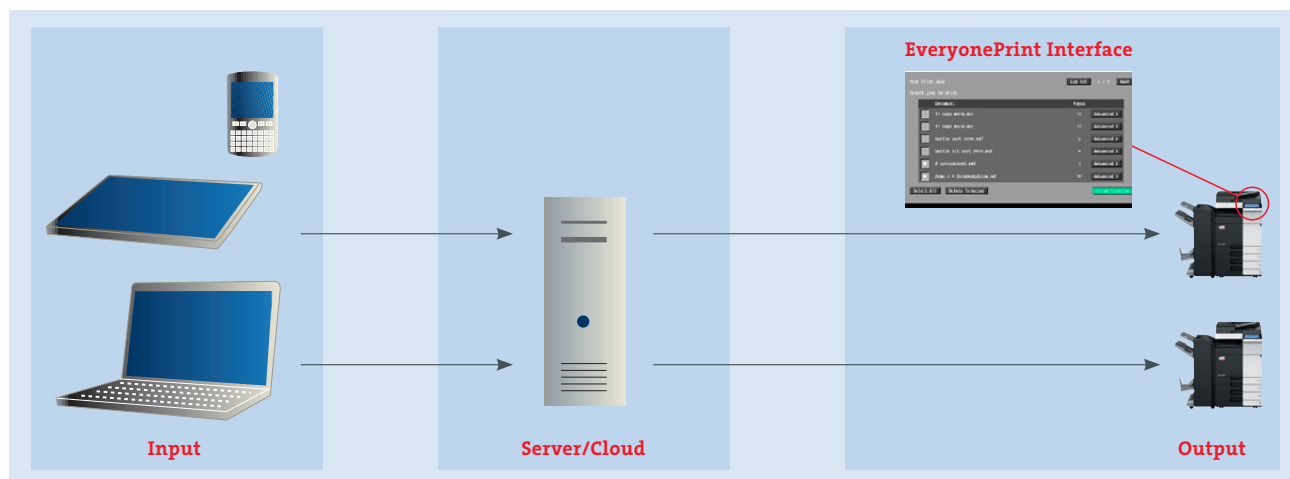
need to manage any applications on the client side. EveryonePrint offers platform- and device-independent printing of office related documents, and is compatible with any brand of smartphones or other mobile devices.

No software installation on the user’s mobile device is required.
